Title - Wildlife of Aberogwen

Conditions of entry

Photographs taken at NWWT reserve Aberogwen, the Spinnies, since January 2007 are eligible. Wildlife must be an important element of the photograph.

Note - Staff and trustees of NWWT are not eligible to enter.

Entry fee - £5 per 3 images

Closing date - December 1st 2009

Judges: John Featherstone (Chair Arfon Branch), Ben Stammers (People & Wildlife Officer NWWT), Les Starling (Ruthin Camera Club).

Categories: a) 18 years plus b) 17 years and under

Entries may be prints or digital, B & W or colour and must be the original work of the entrant and taken within the boundary of nature reserve. (See map at reserve)

Maximum size A4, unmounted. Digital images must be supplied as JPEGs by email or on CD's, max. 300dpi

1st prize both categories - £50 voucher from Cambrian photography and publication of the winning photo in Welsh Wildlife/*Natur Cymreig*, the national magazine of the Welsh Wildlife Trusts, together with runners up photographs on the NWWT website. Winners to be announced in the Spring 2010 edition of *Natur*. Other prizes may be awarded.

The photographers retain the copyright of their photographs, but these may be used for educational or publicity purposes by the NWWT with appropriate credit.
