Autumn is a great time of year to visit our nature reserves and discover why they are such special places.

Wednesday 4th November

Gwaith Powdwr, near Penrhyndeudraeth, Gwynedd.

From 1865 until 1995 this site was home to a world-renowned explosives factory. The Wildlife Trust took over the site when it was decommissioned in 1998 & since then nature has flourished. Our work focusses on maintaining the variety of habitats whilst protecting the history of the site. We will be carrying out various tasks around the reserve. Please contact Rob for more details.

Cors Goch, near Llanbedrgoch, Anglesey.

Today we will be cutting firebreaks on the Castell area of the nature reserve to increase structural diversity. Don't forget your wellies! Please contact Matt for more details.

Bryn Pydew, Glanwydden, near Llandudno, Conwy.

We will be carrying out work in the glades on this lovely limestone-based nature reserve. Please contact Rob for more details.

A variety of tasks around the nature reserve, including looking after some of the historic buildings which remind us of the site's industrial past. Please contact Rob for more details.

Today we will be carrying out heathland management work. This work is essential to ensure that vulnerable plants such as the pale dog-violet and marsh gentian continue to thrive. Please contact Matt for more details.

Greenacres, Morfa Bychan, near Porthmadog, Gwynedd.

This nature reserve is a great example of increasingly rare dune habitat. We will be clearing and burning scrub and willow to reduce colonisation of botanically rich habitat. Please contact Rob for more details.

Gwaith Powdwr, near Penrhyndeudraeth, Gwynedd.

Thursday 19th November

Rhiwledyn, Llandudno, (Conwy County).

Rhiwledyn, also known as the Little Orme, has stunning sea views and wonderful limestone grassland wildlife. We will be carrying out scrub control to prevent it overtaking the precious species-rich limestone grassland areas. There may be time for some seal-spotting! Please contact Rob for more details.
