

North Wales Wildlife Trust Nature Reserve Work Parties in NE Wales (Denbighshire, Flintshire & Wrexham) March 2021

Thank you for your interest in volunteering with North Wales Wildlife Trust. Although Wales is currently under Coronavirus Alert Level 4 restrictions, we are able to continue to run a programme of conservation tasks that volunteers are allowed to attend, given that travelling to provide "voluntary or charitable services" is permitted by Welsh Government. This programme lists the volunteering opportunities that are available throughout March 2021 on our nature reserves in Denbighshire, Flintshire & Wrexham and as part of our Wrexham Industrial Estate (WIE) Living Landscape project. Aberduna, Maeshafn, near Mold. Meet at the office car park. 10 a.m. until 3.30 p.m. Today we will be continuing our seasonal hazel coppicing and clearing bramble to benefit woodland flora and the small pearl bordered fritillary butterfly. Please contact Mike Klymko if you would like to attend.

Wednesday 3rd March

Minera Quarry, Coedpoeth, near Wrexham. 10 a.m. until 3.30 p.m.

Why not become a Minera Quarry Volunteer and witness the incredible power of nature as it slowly reclaims this former lead and limestone quarry into a wildlife haven? In the long term, we aim to create a mosaic of habitats showing the full successional story from bare rock to established woodland, as well as protecting important populations of protected species, such as bats. There will be a variety of tasks to cater for all abilities including improving access, signage, scrub clearance, grass cutting, fencing and wildlife surveys. Meet at the office car park. 10 a.m. until 3.30 p.m. Aberduna is a striking 20-hectare reserve offering stunning views across the Alyn Valley to Moel Famau & the Clwydian Range. The entire site is underlain by limestone which influences the habitats found on the nature reserve. Today we will be continuing with the seasonal hazel coppicing which will benefit the woodland flora and the small pearl bordered fritillary butterfly.
